

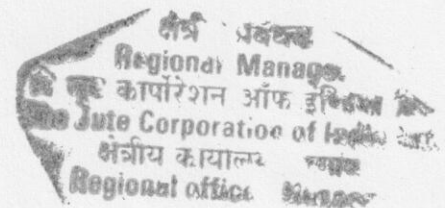



1. The Annexure duly filled are to be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes super scribed **A-Technical Bid** containing **Annexure B** along with EMD and **B-Price Bid containing Annexure C**, both the envelopes are then to be kept in another sealed envelope super scribing Tender No. & **"TENDER FOR DISPOSAL OF OLD AND DAMAGED RAW JUTE UNDER THE JUTE CORPORATION OF INDIA (NAGAON)"** addressed to the Regional Manager of The Jute Corporation of India Limited along with name and address of the tender. Completed bids in all respect should be dropped in tender box kept in our office at Nagaon Regional Office, Ram Krishna Road, Nagaon, Assam-782001.

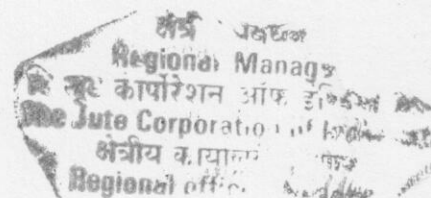

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Each tender is to be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Bank Draft from any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank for Rs.8,492.00 in the name of The Jute Corporation of India Limited payable at Guwahati, Cheques will not be accepted. In the event of tenders not being accepted this Demand Draft will be refunded to the unsuccessful Tendered after finalization of tender. No Tender will be considered without Earnest Money Deposit.

On contract being awarded, the EMD of the successful bidder will be converted into performance security deposit and the Performance Security Deposit shall be released to the bidder after completion of the contract period only and on being satisfied of the successful completion of the contract and ensuring that no liabilities are due from the bidder. In case of any complaint or pending dues, the Performance Security Deposit shall be released only when the said due(s) is cleared by the bidder and/or when the complaint is resolved. The Performance Security Deposit will not carry any interest amount.

2. Reference to any deposit with The Jute Corporation of India Limited shall not be considered as EMD for the Tender.

3. The Tender offer shall be valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of the tender.

4. The successful Tenderers will be intimated after finalization of tender, the Tenderers should make their own arrangements at their own cost to clear and lift the materials from the DPC's of JCI under Nagaon R.O (As per Annexure-A), Nagaon during normal working hours. Failure on their part to deposit the entire quoted value of materials within the stipulated period will lead to forfeiture of their entire tender deposit without any further reference / notice to them and the materials would be resold by us at our discretion.

5. The successful Tenderers will have to pay the full sale value within 10(ten) days of acceptance of the offer and remove the materials from our DPC's within 30 (Thirty) days of acceptance of offer.

6. In case of delay in depositing the full amount of the accepted offer within the stipulated period, interest / penalty may be levied or EMD will be forfeited for the balance amount for the delay period at the discretion of the Corporation.

7. The Corporation does not bind itself to accept the highest offer and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders either in whole or in part and the Corporation will have the right to split up and divide the sale order amongst the Tenderers at its discretion.

8. The materials under disposal are open for inspection on any working day, during working hours after contacting Regional Manager, Jute Corporation of India, Nagaon, Assam-782001, Phone No.9933852817 The Tenderers should thoroughly satisfy themselves with regard to quality and conditions of the materials under disposal offered before sending their tenders and no complaint of any sort whatsoever will be entertained afterwards in this respect while taking delivery of the materials or thereafter.

12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION & GOVERNING LAWS

Any dispute, differences or controversy of what so ever nature between the parties arising out of or in relation to this NIT/ contract, the dispute shall in the first instance be attempted to be resolved amicably through discussions/negotiations between the parties. Further, all questions, disputes and/or differences arising under or in connection with the NIT/ contract or touching or relating to construction, meaning, scope, performance, operation or effect of the NIT/contract same or the validity or the breach thereof, which is not resolved amicably within 15 days, such matter or matters shall be referred for Arbitration. The Arbitrator (other than the employee of the parties hereto) shall be a Sole Arbitrator to be mutually appointed by both parties within a period of 15 days, failing which the sole Arbitrator shall be appointed as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended and the decision/ award of the Sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the parties hereto. The language of the arbitration shall be English and the seat of the arbitration shall be at Kolkata.

In case the award passed by the arbitrator, is assailed/ referred before the court of law, the same shall be exclusively subject to the jurisdiction of Courts at Kolkata.

This NIT/ Contract shall be interpreted and constructed in accordance with Indian laws and only the Courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matters arising out of this NIT/ Contract.

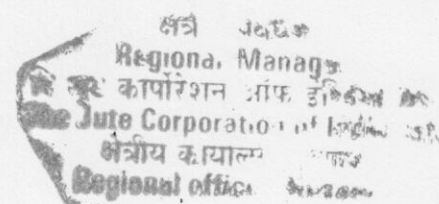
